ABOUT FREE WALKATIVE TOUR ORGANIZATION

They promote the variety of Poland available for everyone. Since 2007 they've guided more than 150.000 people with the goals as similar as YESD targets.

- Supporting the promotion of tourism and sightseeing Activities on behalf of European integration and the development of contacts and cooperation between peoples Promotion of Poland abroad
- Maintaining and disseminating national traditions and Polish culture, and nurturing national, civic and cultural development

They perform these tasks by:

- Promotion of cultural events in Poland
- Educational activities in the field
- Popularisation of Polish and local customs
- Dissemination of knowledge about the Polish national heritage, with particular emphasis on sites on the UNESCO Heritage List

2. THE NATIONAL FEDERATION OF POLISH NGOS, OFOP

The National Federation of Polish NGOs (Nationwide Federation of Non-governmental Organizations, OFOP) was established in 2003 by the initiative of Poland. As many as their members are also federations of organizations, indirectly OFOP may claim over 400 member organizations.

- ☐ Support people with all kind of disability, fever opportunities, especially Deaf, Hard of Hearing and Deaf Blind

- ☐ Realization of cultural, sports/ recreation, research and education.
- ☐ Organization and conducting various forms of formal, non - formal and informal learning and activities.
- ☐ Organizing and promoting the idea of volunteering.
- ☐ Organizing and conducting trainings, therapy and rehabilitations.

5. AKTYWIZACJA FOUNDATION OR THE ACTIVIZATION FOUNDATION

The Activation Foundation was established in 1990 on the initiative of the Warsaw when some mathematicians and IT specialists wanted to help their colleagues who were moving in wheelchairs. Because of physical barriers, people with disabilities had difficulties in finding a job, regardless of their intellectual potential.

Over the years, the Foundation has changed its objectives and started to conduct computer training for people with disabilities from the area of Warsaw, who had at least secondary education and wanted to enter the labor market.

Currently, the Foundation helps people with all types and degrees of disability, regardless of their professional profile, education, social situation or place of residence.

People with disabilities benefiting from the Foundation's support receive multidimensional support, including the opportunity to acquire knowledge and professional skills.

6. VISIT EVS VOLUNTEERS

RA I DO sends their volunteers to other countries to get involved into some community activities, projects and also receive EVS volunteers from other countries to Poland, running some meaningful EVS projects like
