The main goal of the training in Greece is for participants to acquire basic skills for successful planning, creation, editing, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of project activities on the YES HUB e-learning platform. This is a prerequisite for successfully and responsibly assuming the role of an e-mentor. Therefore, the key activities will be focused precisely on the development of the aforementioned key skills through presentation, discussion, knowledge and experience sharing activities, as well as through the process of creating new learning content.

Course objectives

Objective 1: Equip E-mentors with the comprehensive knowledge and skills necessary to effectively mentor young beneficiaries on the youthclub.eu platform, focusing on developing their profiles as social entrepreneurs and guiding them to initiate community projects.

Objective 2: Foster a collaborative network among E-mentor, encouraging the exchange of best practices, innovative educational methods, and cross-cultural insights to enhance the support provided to young future social entrepreneurs.

Objective 3: Empower e-mentors to effectively plan, develop, and deliver learning content and activities for future young social entrepreneurs through non-formal education, in line with the principles of pedagogy, andragogy, and Universal Design for Learning (UDL).

Objective 4: Enable e-mentors to efficiently manage tools for creating, publishing, and managing educational content in virtual learning environments, particularly through e-learning and the YES HUB e-learning platform.

Objective 5: Equip e-mentors with the skills to effectively monitor and evaluate educational activities on the e-learning platform, enabling them to objectively track participants' activities, progress, and needs, and to respond promptly to their requirements.

How to prepare:

1. Each participant must take part in e-stream training and develop a project idea. From the project ideas of the participants (4 or 5 ideas) the partner will choose only **one idea which they will develop together as an application for a common project.**
This application will be discussed and evaluated before or during the training course in Greece.
2. Each group should prepare a presentation:
 - a) How do they see their **benefit as E-mentors** of youthclub.eu? Through this presentation we aim to understand the perspectives of individuals serving as E-mentors for youthclub.eu regarding the benefits they perceive from their role. By exploring how E-mentors view their contributions and personal gains, we will be able to gain insights into their motivations, satisfaction levels, and potential areas for improvement within the mentoring program.
 - b) Preparation of a quiz incorporating a mix of correct and wrong behaviors (**five correct and five wrong behaviors**) of an E-mentor of Yes Hub. Participants will be challenged to identify the key attributes of effective E-mentoring and recognize behaviors that could affect negatively the mentoring relationship. Each quiz will be tested during the training and the content will be used as resource in the upcoming tools. Aim of the quiz is to encourage critical thinking and reinforce the importance of maintaining professionalism and ethical conduct in mentorship roles.

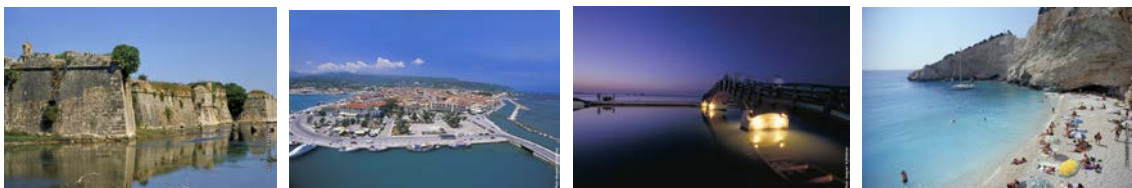

Venue

Our project will take place in Lefkada Island.

The island of Lefkada, also called Lefkas, is the fourth largest island of the Ionian Islands, after Zakynthos, Kefalonia and Corfu. It has an area of 303 square kilometres, a coastline of 117 kilometres and a population of about 23.000 inhabitants. Lefkada is an island with a wide spiritual tradition and it's situated 378 km from Athens.

Accommodation and food for the exchange

Participants will be hosted in "Nirikos Camping Village" in Lefkada (3 km from Lefkas town).

Transportation

How to arrive to Lefkas:

When you arrive to Athens El. Venizelos Airport you have to take the city bus X93 to the bus station Kifissos, it will take about 60 min and the ticket costs about 6 €. There you have to take the bus to Lefkas which takes 5,5 hours and costs 36.80 €. We will pick you from the bus station of Lefkas to the camping.

Pay attention that there are only 3 buses from Athens to Lefkas (At 7:00, 13:00, 19:00), please organise your flight so as to arrive early in Athens and catch the bus to Lefkas.

We can also reserve your bus ticket to Lefkda with 25% discount.

Very important: Please KEEP ALL THE BILLS, TICKETS AND BOARDING PASSES from your travel, and to send your boarding pass of your return trip, when you will be back home.

If you arrange to arrive in the same time to Athens Airport we can rent a private bus to pick all of you from Athens Airport to the hosting place.

Participation Fee

- 100% of accommodation, basic food and activities are covered by the Erasmus+ programme.
- The travel cost is covered up to the amount covered by the Erasmus+ programme, based on the distance grant support for Erasmus+ mobility.
- Each participant should pay 50 Euros participation fee.

Competences recognition
